This course follows the scope and sequence of the AP[®] Physics 1 course as described by the Advanced Placement Program. These objectives ensure that the student will develop problem-solving skills and a college-level understanding of general physics principles and applications. The curriculum is adjusted each year when the publication of curriculum changes. Students enrolled in the class must take the AP exam. Scientific calculators are used extensively.

Prerequisites: For the enrollment in the class, students must have completed chemistry with a minimum 88% average. Completion of pre-calculus is recommended. Students concurrently registered for pre-calculus should have earned a B+ average in Algebra II and B average in Geometry. Recommendations from current math and science teachers are also required. Administrative discretion applies.
